Thanks for Running an Experiment

We're excited you're making plans to run your own event!

Here you'll find helpful hints and instructions on how to run both a *Mini Experiment* by yourself, or a *Little Experiment* with at least two other Mad Lab Rabbits (fans) in your area, and tips on finding them.

A Mini Experiment is designed to be a personal challenge for the lone Rabbit. See how many games you can get others to play, within the time-frame of an event (ranging from a short social gathering to a muti-day convention). Ideal if your audience is made up of non-gamers. See *Running a Mini Experiment* below.

A Little Experiment is designed to be an organized, scheduled, advertised, public event run by at least three Rabbits, who together know all nine core Looney Labs games. Venues range from stores to single or multi-day conventions, etc. Look for more details on the *Running a Little Experiment* sheet.

Choosing an Experiment If you're mostly just a Blab Rabbit and are new to demoing, try helping out at another Rabbits Little Experiment. A Mini Experiment is also a great way to get your feet wet demoing games to family and friends, or in an informal way at a larger venue. If you are an experienced Demo Rabbit, please take charge and organize a Little Experiment in your home area or at conventions close enough for you to travel to.

Running a Mini Experiment — With simple tools and not a lot of advanced planning.

- 1. Put one of the cute little round game stickers on your "I Can Demo" Rabbit badge for any of the nine games that you feel you can teach someone (and have a copy to play with).
- 2. Find a group of people that you want to teach Looney Labs games to. Maybe at a party or social gathering (at your place or a friend's or relative's). Or at a convention or maybe at lunch each day for a week (at work or school) or in a game store one night a week for a month. Anyplace you hang out and play games with friends, family, or random strangers.
- 3. Stick a "Conducting a Mini Exp" sticker-badge to your shirt and enthusiastically tell people you are running a Mini Experiment. Invite them to be *Test Subjects* by playing a game with you! HINT: If you're running an ongoing event (multiple days) you might want to affix your Test Subjects sticker-badges to index cards with names, that you can bring back to each event.
- Please play games with me!
- 4. When your *Test Subjects* play a game, offer them an *I Played These Games* Mini Experiment sticker-badge with a round game sticker for the game you just played. If they play three games they win a Happy Flower or Star promo card!
